Berlin, Germany's capital, dates to the 13th century. Reminders of the city's turbulent 20th-century history include its Holocaust memorial and the Berlin Wall's graffitied remains. Divided during the Cold War, its 18th-century Brandenburg Gate has become a symbol of reunification. The city's also known for its art scene and modern landmarks like the gold-colored, swoop-roofed Berliner Philharmonie, built in 1963. Berlin is a unique blend of history, culture, and modern innovation. It's home to the East Side Gallery, the longest remaining section of the Berlin Wall, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Museum Island, which houses five major museums.
